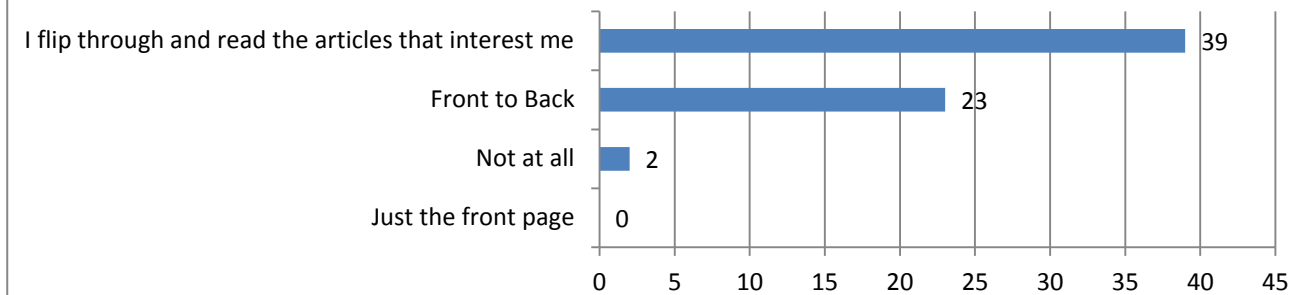


2012 Terwillegar Tribune Survey Results

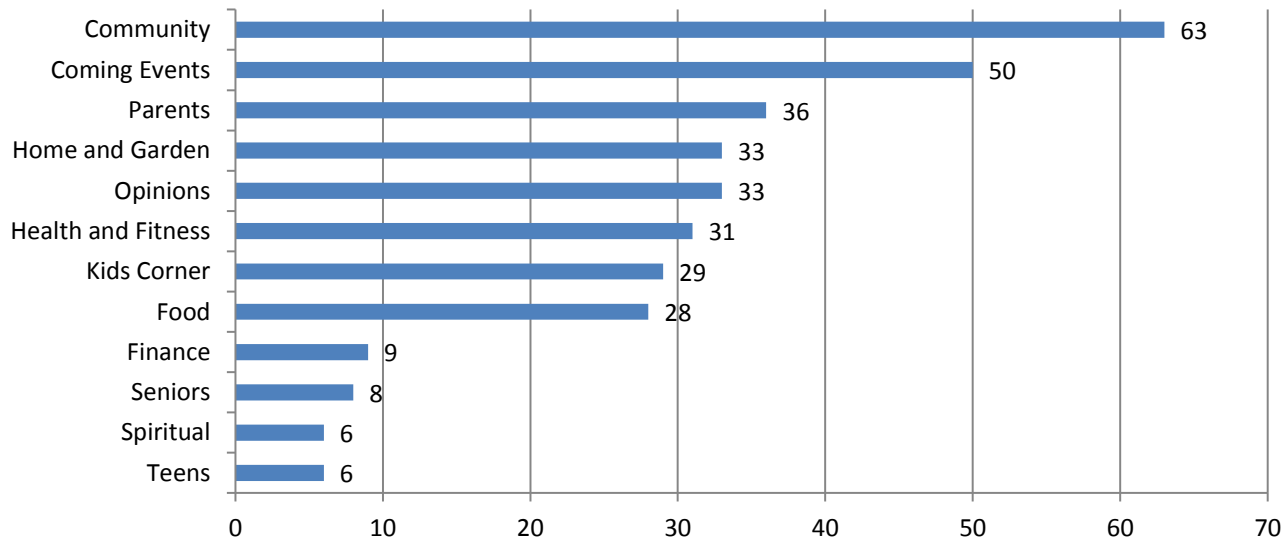
Local businesses are a good way to distribute and encourage readership. I don't mind having copies in my waiting room.

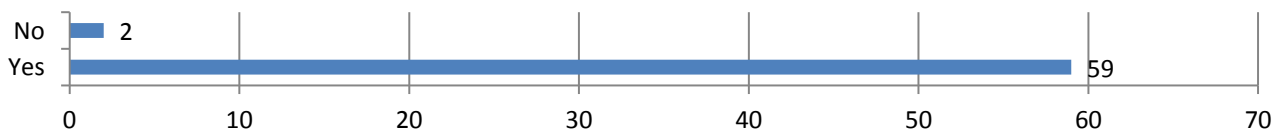
